This form must be used to notify the BHS that an equine passported/over stamped by the society has been castrated, or a microchip has been inserted into the equine, to update the passport with this information. The Central Equine Database will automatically be updated by the PIO upon receipt of this form. **The form must be completed, signed and stamped by an accredited Veterinary Surgeon, and submitted to The BHS registered office address with the passport. The BHS will complete the required changes within 15 working days and return the passport by 2nd Class Signed For™.**
