This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules. Entries

Entries are by invitation only to those that have qualified.

Invites are uploaded to the clubs Sport80 account and can be viewed by the clubs registered committee members.

Entries can only be made through the Sport80 platform.

Entries strictly close at 5pm on Thursday 8 August 2024.

Changes

Changes must be made in writing with the accompanying fit to compete disclaimer up to 90 minutes before the start of the class, after which no changes will be permitted.

Times

Times will be posted on the Riding Club Results website: https://www.ridingclubresults.co.uk/ approximately one week before the championships. Times are selected randomly by computer. Please note that competitors should be ready to jump before their time in case the competition runs early. Please check with the collecting ring steward on the day

Flu Vaccination Certificates

All competing horses and ponies must have an up-to-date full flu vaccination certificate and comply with BRC rules. If your flu vaccination does not comply, or you do not bring the complete record with you, you will be eliminated.

Please note if your horse has restarted, that the time between the initial 3 vaccinations has been altered starting from 1st January 2024. The new time between initial vaccinations can be found in the BRC Handbook 2024.

Hats & Body Protectors

Hats meeting the current standards must be always worn and securely fastened when mounted. It is also advised to wear a hat when handling on the ground. Body Protectors can be worn at riders' discretion. Up to date standards can be found in the BRC Handbook or on the website.

Direct Entry Classes

Direct Entry classes will be available to enter and do not require qualification. Entries for these can be made through Sport80 and are available to add at the bottom of the championship entries class list.

Price per class: £22.00

Veteran Rider classes: Riders must be 55 or over at close of entry to compete in this class. Eligibility for both sections is open.

Veteran Horse classes: Horses must be 15 or over at close of entry to compete in this class. Eligibility for both sections is open.

Coloured Horse: Open to any coloured horse or pony, they do not need to be registered with CHAPS. Horse and rider eligibility is open.

Thoroughbred Type: Open to any thoroughbred/ thoroughbred cross horse/ pony. Does not need to have raced or been registered with Weatherbys. Horse and rider eligibility is open.

Native Type: Horses must be of native type to compete in this class. Horse and rider eligibility is open.

During the Championships

Upon arrival ALL competitors must declare at the Declarations marque; failure to do so will result in elimination. You will need to bring your horses passport with you. Hats can also be tagged at this time.

All other queries at the event including scoring can be dealt with at the Secretary marquee.

Accessibility

Visitors with mobility restrictions, who would usually use motorised vehicles, should contact the secretary's office for information and assistance regarding accessibility at this event.

Parking

Please follow the directions of the car parking attendants. Due to space and numbers, it may not be possible to leave space for other team members/mates to park next to each other.

Presentations

Presentations will be approximately 30 minutes after final results have been posted and depending on space in the presentation ring, provisional times will be added on riding clubs results website as they are confirmed.

Delays to the presentation will be because of objections or queries that will need to be resolved before it can go ahead. Attendance for the presentation will be as per the programme. 1st- 3rd individual and team presentations will be mounted. 4th-10th placing to collect their rosettes from Secretary's marquee.

Salvers

Salvers awarded at championships must be signed for by a nominated person who is then responsible for that salver. It must be returned to arrive at the office on the date stated on the form by recorded delivery and must be packaged with care. Any loss/damage or failure to return the trophy by the specified date will result in the club concerned being invoiced for the cost of a replacement. BRC may also refer such matters to the BRC Discipline Committee.

If a salver is returned without being engraved the club or competitor will be charged the cost to do so.

Official Objections

Protests or complaints may be lodged in writing and accompanied by a deposit of £20. They must be addressed to the Official Steward via the secretary. Protests must be made no later than 30 minutes after the incident that gave rise to that protest or up until 30 minutes after the final results have been published. The deposit will be forfeited unless the protest is upheld or it was decided that there were good and reasonable grounds for lodging the protest.

Dogs

Dogs are permitted on the showground, however they must be kept under control on a short lead at all times and cleared up after. ID tags must be worn.

Do not leave dogs in cars or lorries if it is too hot to do so!

Smoking Policy

There is a strict no smoking policy in the stabling area and in the main arenas onsite.

Exercising Horses

Please see the Important Competitor Information document published with the times. Competitor numbers/bridle numbers/bib numbers must be worn when mounted. Strictly no entry into competition arenas unless competing, doing so will result in disqualification from the competition. There will be no arena walks at this Championships.

Catering

Catering will be available on site. Approximate opening timings can be found in the Important Competitor Information document published with the times.

Toilets

Strictly no emptying of lorry waste (Eslan) in the toilets.

Medical Care

Paramedics will be on site during the competition hours of the championships. Outside of these hours, in an emergency please dial 999.

Vet and Farrier

We will have a vet and farrier on site for this event during competition hours and an on call vet for outside competition hours. Please contact an official on the day for contact details.

Horse Ambulance

A horse ambulance will be present on site during the competition hours of the weekend.

Belongings

BRC are not responsible for competitors belongings, please ensure you lock away any valuables safely.

General information

The whole event will be run on grass. Except Ring 1A and Rind 3 warm up which is surfaced.

Accommodation

There are a number of hotels in the surrounding area, please find more information online. Camping will be available in designated areas with toilets and showers available on site. Please be aware the venue does not permit open flames on site.

Trade Stands

There will be a variety of stands at the event. Further details will be included in the programme.
